



This dress code is established by the Committee and all members are requested to comply with it and to ensure that their guests are aware of it before they arrive at the Club. Those not dressed in accordance with this code will be asked to leave the course.

### ACCEPTABLE

#### Headgear

Worn correctly, facing front.

#### Shirts

Must have a collar (unless a branded golf top), sleeves and tucked in.

#### Trousers / Shorts

Full length trousers or plus fours/twos. Knee length tailored shorts.

#### Socks

Must be worn. Trousers may be tucked in to keep clean.

#### Shoes

Golf shoes.



### UNACCEPTABLE

#### Headgear

Worn back to front.

#### Shirts

Untucked shirts, T-shirts, vests, football/rugby shirts or similar.

#### Trousers / Shorts

No jeans, ¾ length trousers, no beach, sports or denim shorts. No tracksuits or shell suits.

#### Socks

No socks.

#### Shoes

Street, sandals or canvas shoes.

### ACCEPTABLE

#### Shirts

Must have a collar (unless a branded golf top), may be sleeveless. Can be untucked if tailored.

#### Trousers / Shorts / Skirts

Full length trousers, cut offs, tailored shorts and skirts.

#### Socks

Long, ankle and trainer socks.

#### Shoes

Golf Shoes



### UNACCEPTABLE

#### Headgear

Worn back to front.

#### Shirts

Cropped or strappy tops, t-shirts or lycra.

#### Trousers / Shorts / Skirts

sports shorts, denim or lycra.

#### Socks

No socks.

#### Shoes

Street, sandals or heels.
